



Arkansas Goods Exports to the World, 2015-2024




Arkansas Goods Imports from the World, 2015-2024



Arkansas Top Goods Export Partners in 2024




Arkansas Top Goods Import Partners in 2024







Manufactured Goods Categories with the Highest SME Exporter Counts, 2022






Jobs Supported by Arkansas Exports, 2013-2022
